Basic Instructions:

- Obtain materials
- Photocopy pattern (on back)
- Layout patterns and pin in position fabric.
- Carefully cut out the pattern and fabric
- Carefully sew edges. Be sure to leave opening for stuffing
- Stuff Bear. Make sure to use a stuffing stick and get the stuffing in all ears, arms and legs.
- Hand stitch the stuffing hole closed.

Other notes and hints:

- Please remember that these Bears are going to be used by small children. Use good judgment in the type of materials used in their production
- Use whatever cloth material that you have available but please remember that the Bear is being used by small children
- Do NOT sew on eyes or other objects that may pulled off and swallowed by children
- Eyes, mouth and other items may be painted on if you want but are not really needed




